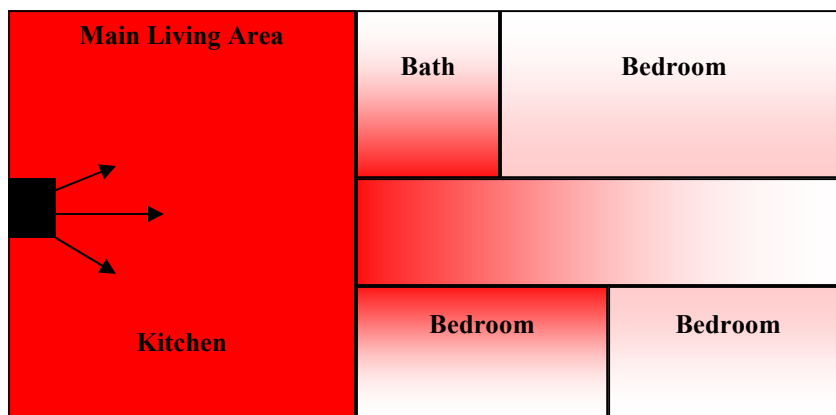


## INSTEAD OF USING YOUR FURNACE—ZONE HEAT WITH A WOOD, PELLET OR GAS APPLIANCE

Many stoves have the capacity to heat an entire house (if a house has good internal air flow), yet they can also be installed as secondary zone heaters to comfortably heat specific smaller areas of the home as well.



Zone heating can save 30-50% on your heating bills. Zone heating with pellet, wood or gas can help reduce fuel consumption, conserve energy and save dollars while maintaining comfort. You can stay warm where you spend most of your time.

The home layout above illustrates how zone heating works; heat will slowly move towards the back of the home, leaving the bedrooms cooler for sleeping.

The **red** indicates how the heat will disperse, keeping you comfortable where the heat is needed most.
